No component defined

The deleting of M9.6 messages can now be run manually if needed. It is no longer a part of the FM update process. FMU calculates the estimated disk space needed for database backup and if that is not sufficient, a button is shown that allows the user to run the delete operation.

Improved progress logging in the FMU UI.

Also improved debug logging. Now, the FMU will write detailed logging information to the file "FM Updater debug.log" in the user's temp directory.

Fixed a bug in FMU where the client folder was not restored after unsuccessfully trying to copy a new FM version to it.

Automatic updater

Re-try closing of open client connections before copying to the client directory. Improved logging of the client connection close operation.

Fixed the calculations of estimated database backup size to use the used space rather than the database file size, and account for the log file backup.

Also, now FMU requires 30% extra free disk space rather than 100%, so for a backup size of 5 GB, a free disk space of 6,5 GB is now required. Before, FMU required the double of the estimated database backup size (10 GB in this example).

When using the FMU UI to install an FM update, the progress is now shown as a list, instead of showing just the current step.
